Implementation

In relation to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders issues, programs will:

- recognise differences within the group.
- encourage individual and group esteem.
- promote development of social skills and attitudes which foster co-operation and participation.
- be encouraged giving parents the opportunity to contribute and participate in the programs to enhance awareness of their culture.

Educators/Staff will:

- recognise and respect the unique cultural identities of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children.
- reinforce and maintain the child's self-esteem and cultural identity.
- recognise non-verbal behaviour as an important part of communication for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children.
- Include an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander perspective in service programs, setting clear, meaningful targets and objectives to create access and inclusion for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children in the service and to become more connected with Aboriginal Australia.
- where possible and feasible employ educators/staff from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander backgrounds.

The Approved Provider/Nominated Supervisor will ensure that this policy is maintained and implemented at all times.
