Educators/Staff will access information, resources, support and ideas from outside agencies to enhance the program, and environment to help demonstrate and encourage anti-bias to gender. Educators/Staff will use these resources to help children recognise and challenge bias.

Educators/Staff will provide equal opportunities for all children to participate in all areas of the program, and demonstrate anti-bias towards gender through their interactions.

Educators/Staff will reflect on their attitudes and practices as well as undertake training as required to support anti-bias policies.

The Approved Provider/Nominated Supervisor will ensure that this policy is maintained and implemented at all times.
